KOHA: INTEGRATED LIBRARY SYSTEM

About Workshop

The information expansion has created hybrid libraries with collections of print and non-print resources. The foremost aim of any library is to systematically catalogue all these resources and to disseminate right information to right user at right time. Library automation has been driven by the ever increasing users' demands and cataloguing of vast variety of informational resources. Before the advent of Open Source Software, libraries were by and large managed by commercial library automation packages. The selection of software was done keeping in mind the financial resources and users' needs. Nowadays libraries have started using Open Source Solutions. Koha is the most widely known Open Source Integrated Library System Automation package. Koha development was initiated in 1999 by Katipo Communications for the Horowhenua Library Trust in New Zealand, and the first installation went live in January 2000.

Koha is web-based ILS, with a SQL database (MySQL preferred) backend with cataloguing data stored in MARC and accessible via Z39.50 protocol. Koha incorporates most of the features that would be expected in an ILS, including:

- Simple, clear interface for librarians and members (patrons)
- Various Web 2.0 facilities like tagging and RSS feeds
- Union catalogue facility & customizable search
- Circulation and borrower management
- Full acquisitions system including budgets and pricing information
- Simple acquisitions system for the smaller library
- Ability to cope with any number of branches, patrons, patron categories, item categories, items, currencies and other data

Objectives of Workshop

- Give an in-depth understanding of Koha software for the use of library automation.
- Conduct hands-on experience for the installation and customization of Linux.
- Undertake practical experience for the installation and customization of Koha on Linux environment.
- Provide hands-on experience of functioning of various modules of Koha.
- Acquaint with live experience of updating and maintenance of records in Koha.

RESOURCE PERSONS

Mr. Basavaraj Talikoti is Master in Library and Information Science and holds PG Diploma in Computer Application. He is serving as Assistant Librarian and Information Officer in Delhi Public Library (DPL), New Delhi since 1989. He successfully implemented Koha in DPL in 2007 and imparted training to other staff of DPL. His expertise includes Linux, Open source software and setting up Koha server. He has been a resource person at various national workshops and conferences. He is a member of Software Committee of National Book Trust of India and Sahitya Academy.

Mr. Vimal Sharma is a Graduate in Computer Application and serving as Project Manager in Chalkpad Technologies, Chandigarh. He has 15 years of experience in managing IT resources in Education Sector. Besides, managing Web Server, Apache Server, MySQL Server, Installation and configuration of Koha, Linux operating system, he has expertise in providing training on Open Source and third party software.

Mr. Jatinder Kumar is postgraduate in Library and Information Science and M.Sc. in Information Technology. Currently he is serving as Deputy Librarian in Chitkara University. He has got 11 years of experience of heading libraries of different Institutes. He is credited with fully automating the Tagore Library of Chitkara University using Koha. He is very well versed with all the functionalities of various Koha modules and has written a Chapter on Koha published in a book titled "Open-Source Solutions in Education: Theory and Practice (USA)". Besides, he has various national and International research publications to his credit. He is a member of Informing Science Institute, USA and reviewer of its publications.
