Syllabus for BLIS Entrance Test: 2014-2015

The admission to BLIS Course will be based on the merit determined by an entrance test with a weightage of 85% marks for objective type multiple choice questions, and an essay writing with a weightage of 15% marks. The test duration will be 1:45 hours. There will be no interview.

The syllabus of the entrance test will be as follows:

General Knowledge Section-A:

85 Marks

Graduate level, based on multiple choice questions. There will be four alternate answers for each question. The candidate will have to select one of the answers considered most appropriate. There will be negative marking with a weightage of 0.25 marks for each wrong answer.

Section -B:

Essay Writing

15 Marks

The candidate will have to write an essay on a given theme in about 200 words. There will be 7.5 marks for the content and 7.5 marks for style.

Total

100 Marks
