3. The minimum cut-off percentage of marks in the Examination is 50% for UR, 45% for OBC vacancies and 40% for SC/ST vacancies in each component and aggregate. The above percentages are relaxable by 5% in case of physically handicapped persons of relevant disability and category. However, no candidate under PH category having relevant disability has been found eligible for appearing in the Main Examination.

SC/ST candidates declared qualified who have obtained less than 50% marks or who have availed age benefit on the basis of caste may note that at present there is no vacancy in SC and ST categories.
