

Dear Sir/Madam,

The Central Government and the University Grants Commission (UGC) have laid down various provisions for regulating recruitment of teachers and academic staff in universities and colleges and their career advancement in UGC funded institutions. However, the continuing vacancies in central government funded institutions is a matter of concern as these universities and colleges have to discharge their role as pace setting institutions in their areas of operation. The Government has also received recommendations regarding the scheme of academic and research requirements governing direct recruitment and career advancement of teachers in universities and colleges. These recommendations would also have implications on higher educational institutions in the States.


- 2. The Central Government, therefore, in larger public interest of attracting, retaining talented potential and selection of the most meritorious to the teaching profession, has constituted a Committee under the Chairmanship of Prof. Arun Nigavekar, former Chairman, UGC *inter alia* to review the following:-
  - (a) Evaluation of the Academic Performance Indicator (API) Scheme as regards the entry point and Career Advancement of Teachers by taking into account its criticism and suggest suitable improvements/alternatives.
  - (b) Evaluation of Ph.D./NET qualifications for entry of Teachers and to accordingly suggest a policy for selections.
- 3. In order to take a holistic and considered view, it has been decided to obtain the views of State/UT Governments on the above mentioned 2 points. Kindly send the views/suggestions (in not more than 300 words) of the State/UT Government, in the attached format, latest by 20<sup>th</sup> September, 2015 for placing the same before the Committee for its consideration.
