The Central University of Rajasthan has been established by an Act of Parliament, the Central Universities Act 2009. The University started working temporarily from Jaipur and introduced two PG programmes in 2009-10, namely M.Sc./M.A. Statistics and M.Sc. Tech Mathematics in collaboration with Malaviya National Institute of Technology(MNIT), Jaipur.

In 2010, the University was allotted over 518+ acres of land at Bandarsindri on Jaipur-Ajmer Road (NH-8), about 85 kms from Jaipur and 45 kms from Ajmer for establishment of its permanent campus. The University launched six new P.G. Programmes in the academic year 2010-11 from its temporary campus at Kishangarh. These were M.A. in English and Economics, M.Sc. in Chemistry and Computer Science, M.Tech. in Computer Science & Engineering and M.B.A.

In 2011-12, six more P.G. Programmes namely M.A. in Hindi and Culture & Media Studies, M.Sc. in Physics, Environmental Science and Biotechnology and M.Arch.

With effect from academic year 2012-13, the University has started six additional P.G. Programmes i.e. M. Pharm. (Specialization in Pharmaceutical Chemistry), M.A. in Public Policy, Law and Governance, M.A. in Social Work, M.Com., M.Sc. in Biochemistry and M.Sc. in Microbiology. The University is also offering Ph.D. in all Academic Departments. All these programmes are unique, futuristic in nature and have high job potential.

Meeting the high academic standards and keeping the pace of its unabated growth, the university has started Integrated M. Sc. Programme in Biochemistry, Biotechnology, Chemistry, Computer Science, Economics, Environmental Science, Mathematics, Microbiology, Physics and Statistics from the academic session 2013-14 and Integrated M.Sc. B.Ed. Programmes in Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and Economics from the academic session 2015-16.
