The Manifesto for ILA Election (2019-2022):

1. Establish a democratic culture at the ILA, in its functioning activities and elections and to ensure it as a worldwide identity.
2. Create an online platform for the regular exchange of information and views among members for wide distribution of information, the portal will also host a registry of all the LIS jobs posted throughout the country.
3. Protection to library professionals from any type of harassment and exploitation at the workplace.
4. Emphasis on the setting up of a standard minimum salary for the Library Professionals in private sectors equivalent to Govt. norms.
5. To pursue National Funding Agencies to increase funds for research projects to librarians and LIS faculty for the advancement of Research and Development in LIS.

10. Initiate for the establishment of a council similar to that of (Medical Council, Bar Council and more) for the development of library science profession.
